Nina Dillon previously served on the Goulburn Mulwaree Council from 2008 – 2012 returning to office in 2024 and becoming Mayor in October.

With a strong background in community service, Nina represented the Council on various committees during her first term, including the Economic Development Committee, the Southern Area Health Committee, the Showgrounds Committee, the Tarago Veolia Community Committee, and the Hawkesbury Nepean Water LG Committee, where she served as Chairperson.
