Collections due to take place on 18th April will occur the following day. Collections due to take place on 25th December will occur the following day. Collections due to take place on 26th December will occur the following day.

## GREEN LID BIN - FOOD ORGANICS AND GARDEN ORGANICS (FOGO)

All garden organics and food waste goes in the green lid bin, either loose, or in a Council issued certified compostable bag. These certified compostable bags are available for free from Council.

This information may differ from the information on your kitchen caddy lid, due to updated FOGO guidelines - please refer to this calendar or contact us for the most current information.

- Raw or cooked food, meat and seafood, bones, dairy, eggshells, tea leaves, coffee grounds, all fruit and vegetable scraps, grass, leaves, weeds, garden prunings and Council issued compostable bags ONLY.
- ★ Garbage, recyclables, plastic bags, soft plastic, polystyrene, coffee cups, compostable packaging, paper, cardboard, shredded paper, pizza boxes, tea bags, paper towel, tissues, serviettes, wooden cutlery, ash, timber offcuts, nappies, needles, gas bottles, motor oil or any hazardous items.

## YELLOW LID BIN - COMMINGLED RECYCLING

Your recycling is hand sorted so please keep it clean and safe. Recyclables must be loose in the bin, not in plastic bag or box.

- Paper and cardboard, glass bottles and jars (no lids), aluminium and steel cans, aluminium foil (rolled into a fist-size ball), milk and juice cartons, hard plastics marked 1 to 5 ONLY.
- ★ Garbage, plastic bags, soft plastics, aerosol cans, polystyrene, coffe cups, compostable packing, shredded paper, soiled pizza boxes, tea bages, paper towel, tissues, serviettes, wooden cutlery, nappies, needles, gas bottles, motor oil or any hazardous items.

### **RED LID BIN - LANDFILL WASTE**

Everything you put in your red bin goes to landfill, where it takes up valuable space and is a lost resource.

- ✓ Plastic bags, soft plastics, nappies, sanitary items, coffee cups, soiled paper and cardboard, shredded paper, broken glass, drinkware and crockery.
- NO food waste, garden waste, recyclables, needles, gas bottles, motor oil or any hazardous items.

#### **DISPOSING OF ASBESTOS**

Goulburn Waste Management Centre accepts correctly wrapped asbestos for disposal at the same price as mixed waste. To bring asbestos to the centre, you must book by phoning the Waste Info Line on (02) 4823 4417 or the Gatehouse on (02) 4823 4839.

#### **BIN PLACEMENT**

Please present your bins at least **1 metre apart** and away from each other and obstruction such as trees, parked cars or poles. If your bins are obstructed, they may not be emptied. Bins must be returned to the property promptly after collection.

#### **COMPOST**

Council uses your food and garden waste to produce high quality compost, which can be purchased from Goulburn Waste Management Centre (subject to availability).

#### **SLOW DOWN**

Take care when driving past waste collection vehicles. Staff are regularly working alongside the vehicles.

#### **MEDICAL WASTE**

Medical waste must go in dedicated medical waste containers and bins. Talk to your medical professional for advice.

#### HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL CLEANOUT

An annual **Household Chemical CleanOut** is held for domestic quantities of chemicals and some hazardous waste. Phone the Waste Info Line for more information.
